## KS4 Careers within the Curriculum

## Intent:

Our careers and work-related learning curriculum at Springwell has been designed in order to:

- Raise the aspirations of all young people
- Challenge stereotypical thinking (in terms of gender etc)
- Increase motivation by linking activities in school with preparation for life post 16
- Ensure that all students are able to make and plan for positive choices about their future
- Ensure that all students have a positive destination to move onto when they leave Springwell
- Meet the Gatsby Benchmarks and our statutory requirements under section 42a of the Education Act 1997

Pupils will study a range of areas of careers and life after post-16 age within the curriculum and through a range of subjects.

## Year 1

Term 1	Personal Development	<ul> <li>Be clear about laws in relation to education and leaving school.</li> <li>Consider personal interests and how these can be related to a career.</li> <li>Research colleges and courses nearby and which are relevant to my area of interest.</li> <li>Write a CV and cover letter suitable to be used for a work experience placement.</li> </ul>
Term 2	Science	<ul> <li>Explore the variety of careers within the NHS and healthcare systems.</li> <li>Compare the benefits of working within the NHS with the sacrifices you might need to make.</li> <li>Identify various educational paths needed for careers within the NHS.</li> </ul>
Term 3	Food Technology	<ul> <li>Study the requirements to become a chef.</li> <li>Research a variety of work environments where a chef is a profession.</li> <li>Examine the intensity of working in a kitchen including the hours worked for preparation, cooking, cleaning etc.</li> </ul>
Term 4	Personal Development	<ul> <li>Research careers in relation to the justice system i.e. judges, solicitors, police officers etc.</li> <li>Be clear about agencies and how these support young people and the personal characteristics required to work for these local agencies.</li> </ul>
Term 5	Personal Development	<ul> <li>Research the hierarchy of different workplace institutions.</li> </ul>

		• Explore the practices different workplaces follow with regards complaint procedures, sickness etc.
	Maths	<ul> <li>Identify careers that use skills related to circles with a particular focus on the construction industry.</li> </ul>
Term 6	AQA Unit Awards	<ul> <li>Study the work of artists to uncover how their career as an artist began.</li> <li>Explain the role of match officials in various sports.</li> </ul>

## Year 2

Term 1	Personal Development	<ul> <li>Find out key information about the employer and/or place of work from material provided by the employer and one or more additional sources.</li> <li>From the application information provided by the employer, identify key details about the job role or placement.</li> <li>Prepare answers to questions that might be asked at the interview.</li> <li>Identify questions to ask which show interest in the job, placement or course.</li> <li>Plan a route, means of transport and travel times to enable punctual arrival.</li> <li>Arrive on time for interview.</li> <li>Demonstrate care in personal presentation, as appropriate to the interview.</li> <li>Demonstrate active listening skills.</li> <li>Outline aspects of own interview performance that what went well and where improvements are needed.</li> </ul>
Term 2	Personal Development	<ul> <li>Outline different methods of applying for a job, including common forms of information requested of applicants (e.g. CV, covering letter)Outline different methods of applying for a job.</li> <li>Describe the different types of information typically provided by employers (e.g. job description) to those applying for jobs and the purpose of each.</li> <li>Gather relevant information for a job application.</li> <li>Complete a job application form accurately.</li> <li>Complete a CV for a job application in a given format.</li> <li>Present an appropriate covering letter for a job application.</li> </ul>

Term 3	English	<ul> <li>Be aware of various careers within the media, with a particular focus on acting both on and off stage.</li> <li>Study the lives and careers of authors in English literature with particular focus on their careers in English and the arts.</li> </ul>
Term 4	Maths	<ul> <li>Use ratios to identify the spread of money across various aspects of a business and/or personal wage.</li> </ul>
Term 5		<ul> <li>Present a case study in relation to a scenario linked to social media and online risks, identifying professionals who would need to be involved.</li> <li>Be aware of the police as a potential career path.</li> <li>Identify the various departments within the police force and the hierarchy within.</li> </ul>
